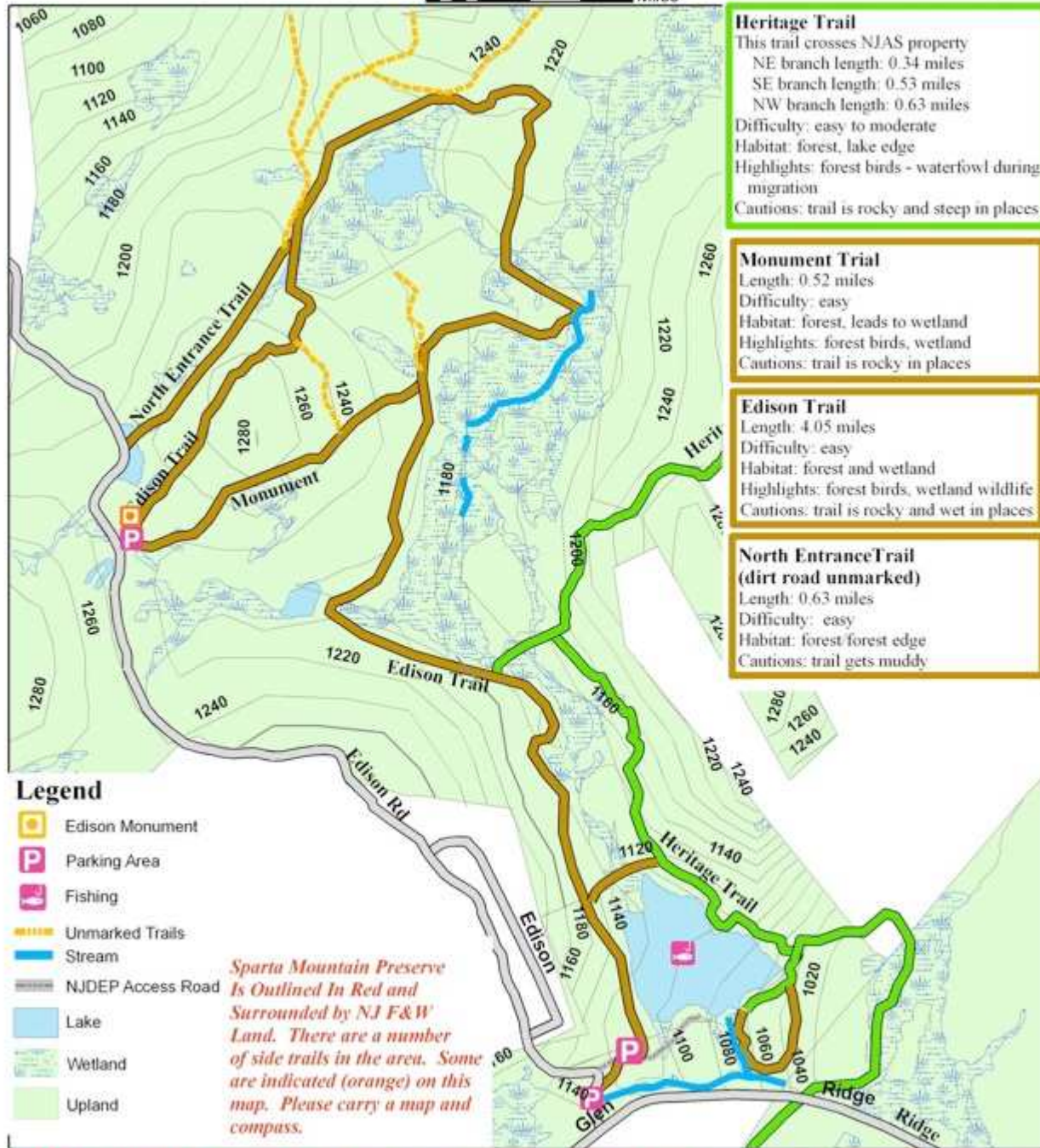




Sparta Mountain Preserve Hiking Trails and Landscape Features

Heritage Trail
 This trail crosses NJAS property
 NE branch length: 0.34 miles
 SE branch length: 0.53 miles
 NW branch length: 0.63 miles
 Difficulty: easy to moderate
 Habitat: forest, lake edge
 Highlights: forest birds - waterfowl during migration
 Cautions: trail is rocky and steep in places

Monument Trial
 Length: 0.52 miles
 Difficulty: easy
 Habitat: forest, leads to wetland
 Highlights: forest birds, wetland
 Cautions: trail is rocky in places

Edison Trail
 Length: 4.05 miles
 Difficulty: easy
 Habitat: forest and wetland
 Highlights: forest birds, wetland wildlife
 Cautions: trail is rocky and wet in places

North Entrance Trail (dirt road unmarked)
 Length: 0.63 miles
 Difficulty: easy
 Habitat: forest forest edge
 Cautions: trail gets muddy
